
#### **WELCOME BACK BOCCI CLUB**

#### LAS VERDES POA BOARD MEETING MINUTES -2023 BUDGET MEETING

November 15, 2022

The meeting was called to order by President Tom Massey at 7:03 p.m., and we opened with the Pledge of Allegiance.

**Roll Call:** There were twelve associations present: Bottlebrush (2), Coconut Palm, Copperleaf, Evergreen, Forsythia, Laurel Oak (2), Oleander, Oliveleaf, Palmetto, Philodendron, Seagrape, and Viburnum. Five associations absent. There was a quorum.

**Approval of Minutes:** There was a motion by Bill Moffa to waive the reading of the most recent Minutes, seconded by Jim Fogarty, motion passed.

**Treasurer's Report:** President Massey announced that Treasurer Judy Morad had to step down from this position and announced that Diane Andruski was appointed Treasurer to complete the term. Diane Andruski reported the following:

Total Operating Cash: \$1,281,937.53

Total Reserves: \$955,651.85

Total Operating and Reserve Funds: \$2,237,589.38

Delinquencies: \$24,784.88

There were no questions. A motion was made by Dick Decelle to approve the Treasurer's Report as read, seconded by Nat DeVardo. Passed.

President's Report: President Massey reported that the holiday lights have been installed and are on. A pump house burned down at Carrotwood and is a total loss. We have filed an insurance claim and are in the process of getting it rebuilt. New lights were installed in the Clubhouse that are dimmable, which make our events nicer. M&P is installing more Clusia outside the fence going south from the entrance on Military Trail. They should be able to complete more that half the distance. We need to wait on a portion due to the eminent domain right turn traffic lane that will be installed.

President Massey reminded everyone to attend the festive Holiday Party on December 10. Diane works hard to plan nice events, and the more people that attend, the more fun we have. Bingo will be on Thursday, and then resume in January.

President Massey reported that we are having some issues with people eating food and bringing glass bottles to the pools. Please remember no food or glass is

allowed. Broken glass can be dangerous and if it gets in the pool, nearly impossible to find.

There were no questions. Jim Fogarty made a motion to accept the President's Report, seconded by Peter Hoyt. Passed.

**Old Business:** FRONT ENTRANCE – We paid for drawings, but could get only one quote for construction, so we will not proceed with moving the Gate House. We will refresh the current Gate House with new paint.

A motion was made by Jim Fogarty to accept the President's Report, seconded by Nat DeVardo. Passed.

**New Business:** BUDGET- President Massey said they worked hard to keep our Monthly Assessments at \$160.00. We were able to maintain the same budget by making some adjustments. Almost all vendors are increasing 3-5% and insurance is a big increase. The Capital Contribution which we passed last year's really helps the budget.

When we went under contract with Hotwire for the cable TV, credit was provided to us for the first three years, but we lose that this next year. Our contract with them is for four more years.

There were no questions about the Budget.

A vote was called to accept the new Budget by a raise of hands. Passed unanimously. For those not on ACH, new coupon books will be sent in December.

There was a motion to accept the New Business Report by Fred Jurnove, seconded by Nat DeVardo, motion passed.

#### **Good and Welfare:**

There was a question about making a sidewalk at the Linton gate to Linton. Since part of the land is owned by Palm Beach County, we will investigate if this is possible. In the meantime, we may paint a lane and have cones so that wheelchairs can use this entrance.

A request for new grips on the pool railings. These will be replaced and are replaced approximately every three months, as the sun is hard on them.

A question was asked about a better system for guests with their IDs at the main entrance. There are other options and Willie is getting quotes.

Since the condominiums will now have increased expenses with the new law, President Massey suggest-





#### MEET YOUR NEIGHBORS-JOE AND SANDY STELLMACK

oe's mother and father lived in upstate New York. Joe's fathers' business partner had a property in Delray Beach near Atlantic Dunes Park. The family would come and visit them and one day made the decision to look at properties in the area. Where they were

staying was out of the question as properties were expensive and insurance was very expensive for places along the ocean and in a flood zone.

In the early 1980s Las Verdes was being developed. At that time, Military Trail was pretty much the end of civilization, and most everything west was agricultural land. There were strawberry fields, orange groves and sugar cane primarily. A U Pick Strawberry farm was on the north side of Atlantic just west of here. There was an orchard called

Hammock Groves and his family would order fruit boxes from there to send to relatives.

Joe's parents decided to look at the models, and his mom picked out a place from the sales brochures. His mother wrote out a check for the property and they closed on the sale in 1982 or 1983. A painting hangs today in the kitchen of the villa that his mom painted. His parents picked out an end unit, as they wanted three walls open, and near the pool. This was very important to them, to be near the pool. It is amusing how this happens, but Joe doesn't recall either of his parents every going to the pool.

The developer of Las Verdes was able to buy lots of land and purposely designed Las Verdes to be in a flower design, with the center being a lake, surrounded by condo buildings and the seven villa associations making up the petals of the flower. Joe feels we are very fortunate that this developer saw the importance of green space as we live on a beautiful property.

His parents became snowbirds at first, and gradually they spent more and more time her. Joe visited frequently and as time went on, he visited more often to help him mother as his father's health declined. When his father passed away, the siblings decided it would be best for mom to be in an assisted living facility in West Palm Beach. The siblings wanted to sell the villa, but Joe felt they should wait and see how mom did in case she wanted to return to Las Verdes. Joe bought his siblings out of their share, and he gradually spent more and more time here. This has always felt like home, and he

has many friends and wonderful neighbors.

Around 29 years ago, Joe was working on an investigation, and he met Sandy as she was a witness in this case. A neighbor who was present at the interview, asked Sandy "if you could go out with one of these gentlemen who would you pick?" She answered, "I'd pick Joe," They became friends, but then over time completely lost touch. Twenty years later, Joe was wrapping up

his career and completing some interviews at a Sheriff's Department in Georgia and he ran into a woman that looked familiar. This employee asked for his ID, and as they chatted, they remembered the connection- this was Sandy's sister. The sister obtained Joe's phone number and gave it to Sandy and told her she had to call the number.

Sandy called Joe and when he answered she asked, "Is this really you?" This was in 2019, and in 2021 they got married in the small town of Hazelhurst, GA, where Sandy is from. She is the youngest of eleven

children with nine surviving siblings. Two brothers and one sister still live in Hazelhurst, GA, three sisters and two brothers live in the North Georgia area. The wedding turned out to be a long overdue family reunion with relatives coming from as far away as Texas. They had a formal wedding out by a gazebo on her brother's property followed by an elegant reception a historic site called "The Big House" a renovated plantation home that was a hotel at one time. The white fences down to the wedding site were decorated with flowers and the pond was dyed blue. It was a wonderful day of celebration.

Joe recalls enjoying many of Laurel Oak's monthly block parties, where they would roll out big grills and everyone would bring their own food to cook. With all the talk of the empty lot, Joe commented about what good foresight the POA President at that time had. Angelo Murgo knew it would be developed with retail and wanted to protect Las Verdes and our green spaces. He worked very hard to get the Las Verdes membership to vote to purchase the land.

Sal's restaurant across the street was Joe's father's favorite restaurant and he really enjoyed a corn beef and pastrami sandwich from Poppie's. Joe would buy a sandwich to split with his dad, and his mom would wonder why her refrigerator wasn't good enough.

Joe and Sandy enjoy going out to watch movies and they like to walk in the Wakodahatchee Wetlands as well as at Green Cay. They love living in Las Verdes, and they are wonderful neighbors for us to have.


