LAS VERDES POA MEETING MINUTES

Board Meeting
January 23, 2024

The meeting was called to order by President Tom Massey at 7:06 PM. we opened with the Pledge of Allegiance.

Roll Call: There were 14 associations present: Aspen, Bottlebrush (2), Carrot Wood, Copperleaf, Cypress, Dogwood, Evergreen, Laurel Oak (2), Oleander, Oliveleaf, Palmetto, Philodendron, Seagrape, and Viburnum.

There was a quorum.

Approval of Minutes: There was a motion by Jack Walsh to waive the reading of the last minutes, seconded by Jim Fogarty, motion passed.

Treasurer's Report: Diane Andruski read the report as of 01/23/2024.

Total Operating Cash: \$1,293,878.62

Total Reserves: \$1,116,035.22

Total Operating and Reserve Funds: \$2,503,988.31

There were no questions. A motion was made by Jack Walsh to accept the Treasurer's Report as read, seconded by Jim Fogarty, motion passed.

Old Business:

There was no old business.

President's Report:

Ficus Bushes to be replaced.

The Ficus bushes around the center loop need to be replaced we have been fighting the white fly's for a while but they seem to have become resistant to the chemicals we are using. We will start replacing them with the Clusia bush like we have at the front entrance they will grow to 8 feet or higher if not trimmed. We will be planting the Clusia bushes starting near Forsythia where they are really thinning out. The bushes we will be planting will be 2 feet high so it will take a year or two to reach 8 feet we will do it in phases not all at once.

Front Entrance – President Massey stated he has been working on replacing the card reader for the visitor side entrance. He has been trying to get a new one installed but wants one that is more user friendly. Going forward he would like a system installed that is easier and safer to use and could still be used if we have no guards in front.

Once we have the new reader installed, we will be ripping up the pavement at the front entrance and exit areas we will be replacing the asphalt. Those are the areas we did not do when we resealed the circle and parking lot because we thought we were going to be making changes out front.

Tiki Hut.

We built the Tiki hut on the concrete pad on the side of the club house using the maintenance fund. The canvas cover that was there was damaged a few years ago was never repaired. We investigated having it replaced it was going to cost \$30,000 to replace it and it only lasts about 5 years. The Tiki

hut cost \$23,000 and will last 8-10 years the grass when it needs to be replaced can be done for \$2,000.00. We have picnic tables back there now and we are buying 2 charcoal grills for the community to use out there. We do suggest if you are having a social event, you should reserve the hut, so it is available for you and your group. We are charging a \$50.00 fee for cleanup, and you must be off the premises no later than 10:00 PM.

The was a motion to accept the President's Report by Nat DeVardo, seconded by Stan Posner, motion passed.

RECIPE OF THE MONTH: STRAWBERRY CUSTARD TART

Indulge your sweet tooth with the delightful simplicity of a homemade Pineapple Upside-Down Cake. Follow this straightforward recipe to create a delectable Pineapple Upside-Down Cake that will have everyone clamoring for seconds.

Serves: 8-10

EQUIPMENT:

- Measuring cups and spoons
- 9-inch round cake pan
- Small frying pan
- Electric hand mixer
- Large and medium mixing bowls
- Spatula
- Off-set spatula

INGREDIENTS:

FOR THE TOPPING:

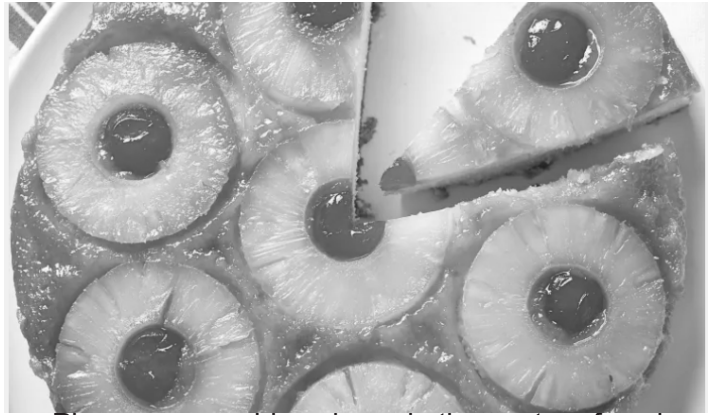
- Cooking spray
- 4 tablespoons unsalted butter
- 1/2 cup packed light brown sugar
- 1 (8-ounce) can pineapple rings in pineapple juice
- 8 to 10 maraschino cherries

FOR THE CAKE:

- 1 1/2 cups all-purpose flour
- 1 teaspoon baking powder
- 1/4 teaspoon salt
- 1 cup granulated sugar
- 8 tablespoons (1 stick) unsalted butter, at room temperature
- 2 large eggs

INSTRUCTIONS:

- **Heat the oven and prepare the pan.** Arrange a rack in the middle of the oven and heat to 350°F. Coat a 9-inch round cake pan with cooking spray; set aside.
- **Melt the butter and sugar for the topping.** Melt the butter and sugar in a small frying pan over medium heat, stirring frequently. The mixture is done when the sugar is bubbly and slightly more brown.
- **Pour the sugar mixture into the baking pan.** Pour the sugar mixture into a prepared cake pan and spread into an even layer to cool slightly.
- **Arrange the pineapple slices and cherries in the cake pan.** Remove the pineapple rings from the can and reserve 1/2 cup of the juice. Set a single ring in the center of the pan, then arrange 6 to 7 rings around the center ring.



- Place a maraschino cherry in the center of each ring and set the pan aside.
- **Whisk together the dry cake ingredients.** Whisk the flour, baking powder, and salt together in a medium bowl; set aside.
- **Cream the sugar and butter together with a hand mixer, then add the eggs.** Place the sugar and butter in a large bowl. Using an electric hand mixer, beat on medium speed until lightened and creamy, about 5 minutes. Add the eggs and beat until smooth, about 1 minute more.
- **Add the flour mixture and pineapple juice in alternating batches.** With the mixer on low speed, add the flour mixture in 3 batches, alternating with the reserved 1/2 cup pineapple juice, in this order: Add 1/3 of the flour mixture and mix until incorporated, about 30 seconds. Add 1/2 of the pineapple juice, mixing until smooth, about 30 seconds. Add another 1/2 of the remaining flour and mix again for about 30 seconds, followed by the remaining pineapple juice and 30 seconds of mixing. Finally, add the remaining flour mixture and mix until completely smooth, about 1 minute total.
- **Spread the batter over the fruit.** The batter will be thick, so use a large spoon to dollop large spoonfuls of the batter evenly over the fruit in the pan. Smooth the batter with an offset spatula, then tap the cake pan lightly on the counter to settle the batter.
- **Bake the cake for 45 minutes.** Bake the cake until dark golden-brown and a cake tester comes out clean, about 45 minutes.
- **Cool the cake for 10 minutes and then invert the cake onto a serving plate.** Remove the warm cake from the oven to a cooling rack and cool for 10 minutes (do not wait longer or the cake will not come out of the pan). Invert a plate over the cake pan and, using kitchen towels or oven mitts to grasp onto both the plate and the cake pan, flip both the pan and the plate over so the pan now sits on top of the plate. Slowly lift the cake pan away. Serve the cake warm or cool before serving and storing.
